# Audi R8C



The Audi R8C was a racing car created by the Audi designer Tony Southgate.

It raced only at Le Mans 24h competition in 1999.

The car featured a monocoque carbon fibre chassis, a carbon fibre body and a 3.595cc twin-turbocharged V8 engine. It hit a maximum speed of 349 Km/h.

James Weaver said that at a certain point during the race, the underdeveloped R8C had turned into one of the best cars he ever drove.

Neither car finished the race and Audi devoted its energies to the open cockpit R8R, whose derivative R8 ended up dominating Le Mans in the years to follow.
